2. **Donate merchandise for an auction**
3. **Give a portion of profits to a shelter**
4. **Place links to rescues on store website**
5. **Give \$1,000 for every \$100,000 in grocery receipts**
6. **Photograph animals for adoption postings**
7. **Provide grooming for shelter animals**
8. **Sponsor newspaper ads**
9. **Designate checkout counter space for collection jars**
10. **Collect animal "food shelf" donations**
